Renowned for its old vines and unique terroir, Priorat was revived in the 1990s and has continued to garner acclaim for its wines that demonstrate uncommon freshness and remarkable aging potential. The slate soil which is known locally as Ilicorella is a defining characteristic of the Celler Vall Llach wines which are all certified organic.

Trinchero will be importing four wines, including the winery's flagship wine – Mas de la Rosa (SRP \$300), which has earned Gran Vinya Classificada, the highest distinction in the classification of wines of the DOQ Priorat. The additional wines include Embruix (SRP \$28), Porrera Vi de Vila White (SRP \$35), and Porrera Vi del Vila Red (SRP \$65). All sales will be managed by the Heritage team, the sales team dedicated to luxury within TFE.
